HAMILTON COUNTY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING TO CLOSE TO PUBLIC EFFECTIVE MARCH 19, 2020

Hamilton County Administrator Jeff Aluotto notified CABR Government Affairs that the Hamilton County Administration Building (*now known as the Todd B. Portune Center for County Government*) at 138 E. Court Street downtown will **CLOSE TO THE PUBLIC** at the end of business today, March 18, 2020.



Starting March 19, 2020, staff will still be present in the building during normal office hours but the public will not be allowed inside the building until further notice.

As many CABR Members are aware, County Recorder offices in our region have already shuttered their offices to public entry. Most real estate work can occur electronically (email, text, etc.) or via FAX.

However, in rare instances where a physical document / item, etc. is necessary, Hamilton County will be setting up a temporary location in the Portune Center that can be accessed by calling ahead of time. Hamilton County will be sharing more details on this in a press conference later this afternoon.
